Resilience IPA brewing event at Campbell Rock Bottom Brewery will benefit Butte County fire victims

Santa Clara County – On Tuesday, December 4, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., Santa Clara County Firefighters Local 1165 will team up with Rock Bottom Brewery in Campbell, CA to brew a batch of Resilience Butte County Proud IPA. The idea is to partner with as many breweries nationwide to raise funds with this ale to be placed on menu as early as December 27th through the end of March.

Sierra Nevada Brewery began the Resilience IPA fundraiser to support the Butte County communities affected by the Camp Fire. To date, over 1000 breweries nationwide have signed up to brew the ale.

Off-duty Santa Clara County Firefighters who were assigned to the Camp Fire will be assisting the brewers and 100% of the proceeds from the beer will be donated to the Camp Fire Relief Fund. Media is welcomed to attend the brewing.
